

# GeoMemorial Commemorative Naming Guidelines

## Saskatchewan Geographic Names Program

The **GeoMemorial Naming Program** honors the sacrifice of Saskatchewan citizens who have given their lives in service to our province and our country by naming natural features in their memory. The program was last expanded in 2006 and now includes:

**Armed Forces Personnel** - including Army, Air Force and Navy regular and reserve members and Peacekeepers while on active duty on UN sanctioned missions

*Criteria:*

- The individual must have been born or raised in Saskatchewan;
- The individual must have been deceased for a time period of 1 year before being considered

**Police Officers and Emergency Responders** – including federal, provincial and municipal law enforcement officers, professional firefighters, and emergency medical services personnel while on active duty

*Criteria*

- The individual must have been born or raised in Saskatchewan;
- The individual must have been deceased for a time period of 1 year before being considered

**Saskatchewan “Persons of Prominence”** - including residents who have made important contributions to the history and development of the province

*Criteria*

- The individual must have been born or raised in Saskatchewan;
- Typically, the individual will have been deceased for a time period of 5 years, however living persons may still be considered.
